

# "PASTOR'S PERSPECTIVE"

# October 2024

In last month's newsletter, I began to share insights from my recent time as a student at Union Presbyterian Seminary. I talked about the organization of worship and drew your attention to the "divisions" (or sections) of worship listed in our weekly bulletin (worship guide). Buffalo designates the fourfold pattern as 1) Gathering Around the Word, 2) Proclaiming the Word, 3) Responding to the Word, and 4) Sending the Word.

Let's go back and look at the purpose of worship. Robert Webber says it this way: "we must understand that when we are worshiping, we are not part of the audience. At best, we are stagehands, and it is Jesus who is the primary actor. The Holy Ghost has already written the script, and God is in the audience. We must understand that at best our job is to make sure that Jesus has the right light upon him so that others may see and connect with him." (Preach! pg. 115)

What are some of our worship practices as Presbyterians? Wherever we see the Word of God purely preached and heard, and the sacraments administered according to Christ's institution, there, it is not to be doubted, a church of God exists [cf. Eph 2:20]' (Calvin's Institutes 4.1.9). While our Jewish ancestors worshipped God on the Sabbath (sundown Friday until sundown Saturday) our Christian tradition marks the Sabbath by worshipping God on Sunday, the day

on which Christ was resurrected. The location of a worship service can be held anywhere a governing body determines. It may include a font, a communion table or alter, or a cross – but these things are not absolutely necessary week in and week out for worship. The two things that are absolutely necessary for worship each and every time it occurs. The Bible and the community of faith. It is best if the Lord's Table and the Baptismal Font are present even when the sacraments are not celebrated as these witness to God's tangible, enacted grace in Communion and Baptism.

Still, more to come in the following months; we are just getting started.
